Seminar Registration

To register for this seminar, please complete the e-registration form and return to MJC by ***Monday, May 21, 2018***. If you are planning to attend, please register so that we can make the necessary arrangements with the hotel.

Hotel Reservations

The Golden Nugget has reserved a block of rooms for the seminar. To make your overnight reservations, follow the instructions on the *Making Reservations* page. MJC will direct bill the \$109 single/double rate (for one room), plus resort fees, for the municipal judges staying for the nights of Wednesday, June 13th and Thursday, June 14th. ***Please note that judges pro tem are responsible for paying their lodging costs.*** All reservations must be made directly with the Golden Nugget and guaranteed with your credit card to confirm your requests. Eligible judges will have the billing of the room rate changed by MJC Staff to our master account at the Golden Nugget *only* after you have checked-in.

Check-in time at the Golden Nugget is 4:00 p.m., with check-out at 11:00 a.m.

Travel and Meal Reimbursement

MJC will provide each municipal judge with a reimbursement form for mileage and applicable meals. ***Judges pro tem are responsible for their own travel and meal expenses.***

Judicial Education

This year's seminar will be held at the Golden Nugget Biloxi. Reservations can be made by calling the Golden Nugget's Reservations Department directly at **1-800-777-7568** and identify yourself with the group code of **S186106** with the group listed as *Municipal Court Judges*. Our room rate for the nights of Wednesday, June 13th and Thursday, June 14th is **\$109.00**, plus the resort fee. Any reservation requests made prior to and/or after these dates are subject to availability and the prevailing hotel rates, local taxes, and resort fees.

The deadline for making reservations with the Golden Nugget in the MJC room block is Monday, May 21, 2018, or until rooms in the block are gone, whichever comes first.

All reservations must be made directly by you with the Golden Nugget and must be guaranteed by a credit card when you contact the hotel. Please be sure to write down your confirmation number. Should cancellation of individual reservations become necessary, the Golden Nugget requires seventy-two (72) hours notice prior to your scheduled check-in time. Failure to not properly cancel your reservation could result in a "no-show" situation where your credit card will be billed.

The Golden Nugget has been instructed to direct bill the eligible judge's room rates, as well as the daily resort fees, for the nights of Wednesday, June 13th and Thursday, June 14th to MJC's master account. This will be done *only* after you arrive at the Golden Nugget and check-in.
